

2016 SMALL BUSINESS BREAKTHROUGH
POWERED BY WEB.COM & JAGUARS BLACK
OFFICIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

By submitting an application to enter the 2016 Small Business Breakthrough Powered by Web.com and Jaguars Black (the "Challenge"), you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions. Failure to comply with these terms and conditions may (in the sole discretion of the Jaguars or Web.com) result in disqualification from the Challenge. To register, you must meet the eligibility requirements and follow the rules regarding the applications (as defined below) set forth herein.

The Challenge is void where prohibited or restricted by applicable laws, rules and legal requirements, and all applicable federal, state and local laws, rules and legal requirements apply. Jacksonville Jaguars, LLC (the "Jaguars") reserves the right to cancel, modify or suspend the Challenge at any time.

Overview. The Challenge is a program designed by the Jaguars and sponsored by Web.com, Inc. ("Web.com") to promote the small and emerging business community in the northeast Florida region. Eligible local business owners are invited to submit an application for an opportunity to be invited as a top finalist to present their business plan to a panel of judges assembled by the Jaguars and Web.com. The panel will use the Judging Criteria (as defined below) to judge the applicants. Subject to meeting all eligibility requirements relating to the Challenge and compliance with all terms and conditions, the business that receives the highest score will receive a one-year sponsorship with the Jaguars for the 2016/17 National Football League ("NFL") season and unique marketing benefits provided by Web.com (collectively, the "Award"). Such sponsorship and marketing benefits are detailed in the Application Site (as defined below) and are subject to change at the sole discretion of the Jaguars or Web.com.

How to Apply. To participate in the Challenge, eligible persons must submit a complete and correct application online at <http://bigstagebigresults.com> (the "Application Site") between May 1, 2016 and May 31, 2016. The completion of the application in its entirety will automatically generate your entry into the Challenge. The information you provide in the application will be used to verify that you meet eligibility requirements for the Challenge. Your answers to any voluntary survey questions will not affect your ability to participate. **ENTRIES MAY NOT BE MAILED.**

Eligibility. Eligibility to participate in the Challenge is limited to persons who:

- (a) are 18 years of age or older as of May 1, 2016;
- (b) are an "Owner" or an "Authorized Agent" of an Eligible Business (in each case, as defined below);

- (d) have a business that has not, and whose officers, directors, managers or partners have not, been convicted of a criminal offense in violation of Sec. 287.133 Florida Statutes;
- (e) are available between June 6th through July 29th for various rounds of interviews should you be selected as one of the top finalists; and
- (f) agree to participate in Jaguars events during the 2016/17 NFL season (dates & times to be determined).

"Owner" is defined as a natural person who: (i) is the primary decision maker for, and has been actively engaged in the day-to-day operation of, the Eligible Business identified in his/her entry form during its existence up to and including at least May 1, 2016; (ii) as of May 1, 2016, owns at least 51% of that Eligible Business; and (iii) as of May 1, 2016, has resided in any of the following counties for at least one (1) year: **Florida:** Nassau, Duval, Clay, Saint Johns, Flagler, Putnam, Alachua, Bradford, Union, Baker, Columbia, Hamilton, Gilchrist, Suwannee, Lafayette, Marion, Lake, Volusia, Seminole, Orange, Brevard, Madison, Taylor, Dixie, Levy, Citrus, Sumter, Taylor, Jefferson, Leon, Wakulla, Gadsden, Liberty, Franklin; **Georgia:** Brooks, Cook, Berrien, Lowndes, Lanier, Echols, Clinch, Atkinson,

“Authorized Agent” is defined as a natural person who is a general partner, controlling manager or principal executive officer or other officer with full power and authority to act on the Eligible Business’s behalf as per the Eligible Business’s organization documents; or a duly authorized representative thereof.

“Eligible Business” is defined as (i) a for-profit business registered to conduct business in one of the fifty (50) United States or District of Columbia; (ii) having its primary physical location residing in the State of Florida; (iii) being independently owned and operated, sole-proprietary, non-franchised, and not a subsidiary of any other established parent business(es); (iv) being founded and engaged in active daily operation no later than May 1, 2016; and (v) having a three (3) year combined gross annual income of 6 million or less for the immediately preceding 3 year period.

If selected, the applicant may be asked to provide proof of business ownership in a form deemed acceptable by the Jaguars and Web.com.

Only one entry per Eligible Business shall be considered. Any effort by an applicant to misrepresent himself or herself through the use of aliases or multiple e-mail addresses or telephone numbers or misrepresent his or her eligibility age will disqualify that applicant. Applications that have been generated by a script, macro, bot or any other automated means will be deemed void. Intellectual Property. By submitting an application, you grant the Jaguars and Web.com the unlimited, worldwide, royalty-free, perpetual, irrevocable, nonexclusive and freely transferable and sublicensable right and license to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, perform, display, distribute, create derivative works from and otherwise disclose to third parties any part and all of such application (including all written material and motion pictures, and all trademarks and logos of the business entity included therein) for any purpose, whether commercial or noncommercial, anywhere, in any form of media, whether now known or later developed. All materials submitted in connection with the Challenge become the property of Jaguars and Web.com and will not be returned.

Finalists Selection. If you are selected as a top finalist, you will be notified by telephone or email on or about June 10, 2016. A maximum of 6 top finalists shall be selected, but the Jaguars or Web.com reserve the right in their sole discretion to select fewer than 6 top finalists for any reason. The Jaguars or Web.com may require the top finalists to execute an affidavit of eligibility, publicity release (except where prohibited), and liability waiver and other documentation (“Affidavit”) prior to the final presentation. If any top finalist fails to execute the Affidavit, or fails to respond to the notification within 48 hours, the Jaguars or Web.com will consider the selected business to have forfeited participation in the Challenge and an alternative top finalist may be selected. The odds of being selected as one of the top finalists depend on the total number of eligible applications received and the final number of top finalists selected as determined by the Jaguars or Web.com.

Duval County, Florida, and each applicant expressly consents to the jurisdiction of and venue in such courts and waives all defenses of lack of jurisdiction and inconvenient forum with respect to such courts; or (2) in the sole discretion of the Jaguars and Web.com, exclusively by final and binding arbitration under the rules of the American Arbitration Association (“AAA”) and held at the AAA regional office nearest the applicant. If the Jaguars and Web.com elect arbitration pursuant to this paragraph, the Federal Arbitration Act shall govern the interpretation, enforcement and all proceedings at such arbitration and judgment upon such arbitration award may be entered in any court having jurisdiction.
